Introduction

The Faith of Abram

❖ **Genesis 12:4-6**

- ❖ Joshua 24:15—*choose this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your fathers served in the region beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you dwell. But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord.*"

❖ **Genesis 12:7-8**

- ❖ Hebrews 11:10—*For he was looking forward to the city that has foundations, whose designer and builder is God.*
- ❖ Hebrews 13:14—*For here we have no lasting city, but we seek the city that is to come.*

❖ **Genesis 12:9**

- 1. God Revealed Himself to Abram**
- 2. God's Revelation of Himself Compels Abram to call upon the name of the Lord and walk in obedience**
- 3. God's Revelation of Himself Compels Abram to Worship**

◆ So what's the point? Why does this pattern matter?

(1) **This pattern reminds us that salvation does not begin with *us making a choice.***

(2) **This pattern shows us who we must be in Christ.**

- ❖ Acts 4:20—*we cannot but speak of what we have seen and heard.*"
