- ❖ Isaiah 53:6—*All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned—every one—to his own way;*
- ❖ Ephesians 2:1-3—*dead in the trespasses and sins in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience— among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind.*
- ❖ John 6:44—*No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him. And I will raise him up on the last day.*
- ❖ Romans 8:7-8—*For the mind that is set on the flesh is hostile to God, for it does not submit to God's law; indeed, it cannot. Those who are in the flesh cannot please God.*

### 2. **Jesus will not loose ONE.**

- ❖ John 6:37-39—*All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never cast out. For I have come down from heaven, not to do my own will but the will of him who sent me. And this is the will of him who sent me, that **I should lose nothing** of all that he has given me, but raise it up on the last day.*

### 3. **Jesus' work ALONE saves us.**

- ❖ Acts 4:12—*there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."*

### 4. **Jesus' plan was crazy...but it worked.**

- ❖ Isaiah 53:3-5—*He was despised and rejected by men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief; and as one from whom men hide their faces he was despised, and we esteemed him not. Surely he has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed.*

### 5. **Jesus makes all things new.**

- ❖ Revelation 21:5—*"Behold, I am making all things new."*
